An artistic intervention is a way to stimulate creativity, personnel development, disruptive thinking, new interactions, and new perspectives – i.e. the core of innovation in organizations. In the heart of artistic interventions is the capacity of artists to subvert and challenge routines, mind-sets and traditional management processes.

Intermediaries are organizations that offer intermediation services between artists and businesses. Intermediaries have a significant role "in acting as an interface between worlds which are only starting to know each other, helping to build trust and understanding of objectives and expectations, and developing or fine-tuning working methods" (European Commission, Green Paper on unlocking the potential of cultural and creative industries. 2010, p. 19).

This free seminar is organized by Theatre Academy Helsinki as part of the EU Culture Programme –funded project Training Artists for Innovation. Training Artists for Innovation (TAFI) is a unique two-year project to investigate creative interventions in business. The project examines the stimulation of innovation and creativity in European businesses through the intervention of artists. At the seminar you get to meet specialists on artistic interventions from Belgium, Denmark, Finland, the Netherlands, Spain and Sweden.
